# Specialty Knives & Tools

**SOG** is a acronym for the <u>Studies and Observations Group</u>, which was a special military group prior to the Vietnam War. This group of tough, intelligent United States service men was assembled in 1964 by the Joint Chiefs of Staff, SOG members executed undercover missions including rescue ops and enemy capture throughout Southeast Asia.



Years later, 1986 to be exact, Spencer Frazer founded SOG Specialty Knives and Tools. Frazer's love for knives as a young boy became a reality when he held his first SOG Bowie. Frazer founded what is now SOG with the goal of replicating the best features of Bowie while maintaining the strength, versatility, and ruggedness associated with Studies and Observations Group.

His first product - a fixed blade commemorative knife that retailed for \$169 based on the original design of a Vietnam military knife.

In 1988 SOG introduced its first folding knife, the Tomcat, which won Blade Magazine's Overall Knife of the Year Award. This was the first of the numerous awards SOG received for innovative products and ideas.

In 1990 SOG introduced the Tool Clip, the company's first multi tool that led them into new and much broader arenas, including the industrial and retail markets.

In 1995 Mr. Frazer invented Compound Leverage multi-tools, a patented design which gives SOG tools vastly superior pliers clamping strength. Today, the company has over 50 patents for their unique inventions.

In 2000, the company created an entirely new-patented concept (SOG Assisted Technology) that made it easier and faster to open a folding knife ambidextrously.

With the introduction of these products, SOG established itself as the first knife manufacturer to expand its line to include a broad scope of folding knives, multipurpose tools, and a deep assortment of fixed blades.

In 2009, SOG partnered with MCC Capital Partners, a private equity firm specializing in the growth of branded consumer products companies.

SOG is well positioned to efficiently and professionally service its growing list of customers, while preserving the SOG traditions of product quality, innovation, and strength of brand. Since 1986 SOG has been creating the strongest, most innovative multi-tools and knives on the market.
