Profile of Florida Knife Maker Lowell Bray Jr.











Lowell Bray has been a knife collector for over forty years and a knife maker since 1985. He lives in New Port Richey. He is the author of over 100 articles in <u>Blade</u> magazine and <u>Knife World's</u> monthly publication. He is also a Field Editor for <u>Blade</u> magazine and writes the popular "Your Knife Rights" column now carried in <u>Blade</u>. Lowell is a member of the Florida Knifemakers' Association, The Knifemakers Guild and is a Journeyman Smith with The American Bladesmith Society.

Lowell specializes in working fixed blades both forged and stock removal. Stock removal blades are made of 440C or ATS-34 stainless steel. Forged blades are made of various high carbon steels and some Damascus of his own making. He also makes a small number of folding knives, using his own lock design. The knives pictured here are representative. He does not make standard models but prefers to make each knife unique. He will also make custom knives of the clients design.

He usually attends the <u>Florida Knifemakers' Association Show</u>, the <u>Knifemakers Guild Show</u>, the <u>Blade Show</u> and the <u>Gator Cutlery Show</u>. At other times, he tries to have at least a few knives in stock.



Oh, I forgot to mention when he is not making knives he is a full-time Circuit Judge.
