### PRUNER / HAWKBILI

Characteristics of this blade include an edge that curves to a point. The blade front flows in a concave fashion, while the reverse side of the blade curves in a convex type fashion. The shape of this blade resembles that of a hawk's bill, hence the name. At one time, this blade was used for pruning shrubs and fruit trees. Uses today include cutting sheetrock, carpet, roofing paper, and other home improvement materials.
