The Guild is composed of 300 knifemaker members and several thousand collectors, writers, and other investors as honorary members.


### **History**

The idea for Knifemakers' Guild came about at a Las Vegas, Nevada gun show held at the <u>Sahara Casino</u> in February 1970. The actual founding occurred in November 1970 by <u>A.G. Russell</u> in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Charter members included <u>Blackie Collins</u>, <u>Bob Loveless</u>, <u>John Nelson Cooper</u>, and Dan Dennehy. Russell was made the first president with Loveless as the Secretary.


The current President is <u>Gil Hibben</u>, past presidents have included <u>Jimmy Lile</u>, <u>Frank Centofante</u>, <u>D'Alton Holder</u>, <u>George Herron</u>, <u>Buster Warenski</u>, and <u>William F. Moran</u>. The Knifemakers' Guild is composed of over 300 members worldwide.

The Knifemakers' Guild hosts an annual show where members meet once a year to conduct business, elect officers, and display their work. The show is attended by thousands of collectors.


