

## **OPINEL KNIVES**



The Opinel knife, a French icon, has a rich history rooted in the Savoie region of the French Alps. **Joseph Opinel, in 1890, designed the first knife**, aiming for a simple, practical tool that was both affordable and robust. Over the decades, the knife gained popularity among farmers, workers, and even became a design icon.

Here's a more detailed look at the Opinel story:

- **1890:** Joseph Opinel, inspired by his love for machinery and manufacturing, created the first Opinel knife.
- **1897:** A series of 12 sizes of Opinel knives, numbered 1 to 12, were introduced.
- 1901-03: Joseph Opinel established his first factory and produced a machine for mass-producing the wooden handles.
- 1909: Joseph Opinel registered the "Crowned Hand" emblem as his trademark.
- 1955: Marcel Opinel, Joseph's son, invented the Virobloc safety twistlock mechanism, enhancing the knife's safety and versatility.
- 1985: The factory moved to Chambéry, continuing the Opinel tradition.
- **2000:** The Virobloc locking mechanism was improved, allowing locking the blade in both open and closed positions.

The Opinel knife's enduring appeal stems from its simple design, high-quality materials, and accessible price point. It has remained a family-run business for over 130 years, with descendants of Joseph Opinel still at the helm.
